I am happy to send you the following information on the forthcoming activities of the Society.

1. 2021 National Conference of ISMS:

Like the last year, due to Covid19 related health risks in the country, this year also, Society's 2021 Annual National Conference shall be organized in virtual mode (i.e., as online event). Thus, the 39th Annual National Conference of ISMS (ISMSCON -2021), will be held in the virtual mode on 9-11 December 2021 with Pre-Conference Courses on 8 December 2021. The First Announcement of ISMSCON-2021 has already been released. The theme of the this Conference will be – *Application of Biostatistical Techniques for Summarizing Evidence :Systematic Review & Meta – Analysis*. For more details, please write to:

Incidentally, 39th Annual Conference of ISMS (2021) is being organized again as an online event. Thus, medals & award-certificates of the 2020 & 2021 awardees are to be presented this year somehow. The Society is planning to organize a separate brief Fellowship &

Awards Ceremony, as a part of 2021 Conference of ISMS. The Ceremony shall be organized & conducted by the ISMS Secretariat in coordination with the 2021 ISMS Conference Organizers.

5. Nominations for the Awards (falling under the purview of the Awards Committee): Nominations for following awards are invited from the ISMS members. These nominations / applications are to be prepared on plain paper and submitted online, attaching necessary documents (visit, http://www.isms-ind.org and refer Fellowship & Awards Rules, PDF File), to Dr R M Pandey, Chair - Awards Committee (E- mail: rmpandey@yahoo.com) with a copy to the General Secretary –ISMS (E-

mail: <u>generalsecretaryisms@gmail.com</u>), so as to reach to the Office of the Society well in time (i.e., on or before the deadline, September 30).

Note: As this year's Annual Conference shall be an online event, nominations / applications for Smt. Saroj Shukla Travel Scholarship, are not being invited .

All candidates, applying for awards should check their eligibility before doing so. Those who have received any award already, are not eligible to apply for the same award again. A published research paper can be sent for only one award at a time. Papers already submitted for any award previously but not considered for the same (i.e., not found suitable due to any reason), should not be submitted again for the same award.

6. Nominations for the Search Committee Awards (falling under the purview of the Search Committee) :

As done before, for awards falling under the purview of the Search Committee, nominations are not required from the general membership of the Society. Search Committee will identify names of Life Members for this purpose and will process them. If Search Committee members are desirous of proposing anybody's name for any such award, they should get in touch (without formal nomination or prior nominee's consent) with Dr B L Verma, Committee–Chair (E-mail: <u>blverma49@gmail.com</u>) well in time (i.e. before the last date, set by the ISMS Secretariat for the purpose). This time ISMS Business Meetings shall be held online only. The dates for the Governing Council Meeting and General Body Meeting will be informed in due course. A further communication in this regard, will soon follow.
